

FIRE LABELS

See:- Furniture and Furnishings (Fire Safety) Regulations 1988 / 1989, 1993 and 2010

It is a legal requirement that we, as a charity, cannot sell or give away donations of upholstered furniture, mattresses or beds that do not have valid fire labels. As a result please do not be offended when we ask if your items comply with this regulation - we cannot collect or accept items that do not comply. The labels will be stitched in place and will include the BS7177 code or hand written batch numbers.
