- Begin to develop an understanding of early British history with creative storytelling of Iron Age settlements and Celtic village life.
- Celtic fancy dress and role play to encourage active multisensory learning, empathy and teamwork.
- Key words are brought to life with artefacts, the ogham alphabet and demonstrations with the scene set during our Celtic storytelling.
- Pupils express their creativity and explore symmetry and natural materials. Learners create Celtic thumb pots, design war shields, and help make Celtic clothes.
- Pupils explore the seasons making comparisons between the Celtic way and the modern way of doing simple things, like food and heating.


