

Your class will explore how nature recycles its waste naturally and then discover what happens to our waste after it has been collected.

All of our inclusive activities challenge each learner's ability to work collaboratively, and include waste audits of the classrooms, shopping games and paper making workshops; allowing learners to think critically and foster confidence in their own curiosity.

Learning outcomes

- Discover how nature recycles its waste
 thinking about how soil is made and what is
 - thinking about how soil is made and what is needed to make it
- Discover what happens to our waste after it has been collected.
- Think about alternative ways of reducing / reusing / recycling waste.
- Recycle materials to make a piece of paper
- Introduce the water cycle and discover how pollution gets into it
- Link water cycle, flooding and home pollutants and how to minimise the detrimental effects.




WASTE WARRIORS can be delivered to your class as a half-day, full-day or to two different classes over the course of a school day
